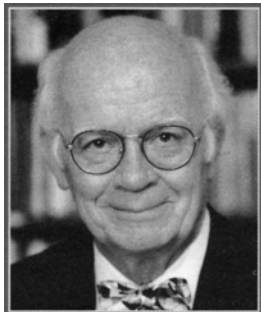

### REV. MARTIN MARTY



Church historian and Professor Emeritus at the University of Chicago, Rev. Martin Marty is highly respected as a religious historian, writer, theologian, and pastor. He is a columnist for "The Christian Century" and

an author of over 50 books as well as over 5000 articles, essays, and papers. Rev. Marty was ordained in 1952 and served churches in the Chicago suburbs for 10 years before joining the staff at the University of Chicago, where he taught for 35 years. He is recipient of numerous awards, including the National Humanities Medal and the National Book Award. He and his wife Harriet have 7 children, 9 grandchildren, and 3 great-grandchildren.
